

Tips for Finding Appropriate eMedia Resources and Using Them

- ❖ Look in the "Curriculum Overview" section beginning on page 9.
- ❖ Read the series descriptions and lessons titles.
- ❖ Check the monthly *eMedia Update* online (www.eMedia.scetv.org) for schedule changes and additional programs announced each month, including staff development. The update is available in PDF and Microsoft Word formats by the 25th of the previous month.
- ❖ Use the online "Broadcast Schedule Search" to find program information and when they are scheduled to air next. The broadcast schedule search can be found at the top of the eMedia homepage at www.eMedia.scetv.org. You may also request programs be recorded from your media specialist or DES. See DES Contact Grid for information on how to contact the DES that serves your district or go to www.scetv.org/education/des.
- ❖ Go to the eMedia Web site to find the broadcast schedule online. (www.eMedia.scetv.org, click on "Broadcast Schedule" for schedule by curriculum area or "Today on eMedia" for the days schedule.) The current list of block feed schedules can be found by clicking on Updated Blockfeed Summary.
- ❖ Ask your media specialist for assistance. Your media specialist may also contact your local DES to request information on programming or have programs or series broadcast for you if they are not scheduled at times you need.
- ❖ Use just one program in a series or just a segment of one lesson... whatever meets your needs. You don't have to use the whole thing!
- ❖ Let your media specialist and local DES know what programs you use and what programs are needed. eMedia works with your media specialist and local DES to determine programming needs and usage. Teachers are welcome to participate in the review and evaluation process for new resources.

Electronic Field Trips/Teleconferences for K-12

A wide variety of electronic field trips and teleconferences for students can be accessed through ETV. The program titles, broadcast dates and information for most of the series are not available until closer to the broadcast dates. The monthly *eMedia Update* will feature information and current broadcast information. Go to www.eMedia.scetv.org to access each month's update, which is posted by the 25th of the pervious month.

Some producers, such as Fairfax Network, provide re-formatted programs and previous year's programs, which are added to the eMedia schedule. When available, the previously produced program titles and broadcast dates are listed. The new electronic field trips and teleconferences will be announced by eMedia and ETV when topics and broadcast dates are known.

REMINDER!

Each of the PBS Series has the same rights. All schools may record these programs as they are broadcast and retain the tape for one year.

Also, except where otherwise noted, program Web sites can be found by visiting pbskids.org and clicking on the desired program title.
