A special two-hour program to assist students and parents in looking for ways to pay for a college education airs January 25, 5:00–7:00 p.m., LIVE on all ETV open circuit channels.

Produced by the State Department of Education's ITV team, **Finding Money for College** features financial aid professionals from public and private colleges and universities in South Carolina. In addition, guidance counselors will offer advice and representatives from the South Carolina Higher Education Tuition Grants, South Carolina Student Loan Corporation and South Carolina Commission on Higher Education can answer questions on accessing scholarships, grants and loans.

Viewers from across the state are invited to call in questions during the LIVE broadcast via a toll-free number that will be announced on air. The information in **Finding Money for College** is very timely and especially needed for seniors and their parents.

In addition to providing key information and a forum for questions to be answered, this year's program features a special segment on high school guidance services to help students find financial help for college that was taped at **Dutch Fork High School** in Lexington School District Five.
