A Gendered Classroom, developed by instructor David Chadwell, provides key information about single-gender education, focusing on six differences between boys and girls, the implications in the classroom, and strategies to meet the needs of individual students. Interviews with teachers from single-gender classes are also a part of the videos. Single-gender education is teaching boys and girls the same high standards within different classrooms. Federal regulations issued in October 2006 authorized the use of single-gender classrooms, programs, and schools within districts as a way to meet the educational needs of its students. Currently, there are over 200 schools within South Carolina that offer some form of single-gender program. Single-gender programs exist in elementary, middle, and high schools.

All class meetings will take place through distance learning. The instructor and participants will communicate via Moodle—the course platform on the Internet. Assignments and discussion forums will be facilitated in Moodle.
