The series has six targeted audiences: administrators, artistic teachers, coordinators of gifted and talented programs, general education teachers, guidance counselors, and teachers of gifted and talented students. Most of the requirements are to view the sessions and then respond to questions about the session or how you plan to use the information in your teaching.
