The ***Primary Sources: Workshops in American History*** self paced course is designed around Annenberg/CPB Professional Development Workshops. Providing high school history teachers the opportunity to explore the use of primary source documents in the research and interpretation of American History, this course presents a fascinating study beginning with pivotal events from the settlement of Jamestown to the Korean conflict and the Cold War. In unique ways, several prominent historians guide the teachers through discussions, debates, interviews and role-playing activities that can be easily adapted for teacher use in his/her own classroom.

All class meetings will take place through distance learning. The instructor and participants will communicate via Moodle — the course platform on the Internet. Assignments and discussion forums will be facilitated in Moodle.
