The ***Science in Focus: Shedding Light on Science*** self paced course is designed around Annenberg/CPB Professional Development Workshops. Providing an opportunity to study the theme of shedding light, this course offers elementary teachers tips for explaining light in Earth science, chemistry, physics, biology, and space science. Because light is an interdisciplinary study topic, it is easy for classroom activities to make meaningful connections to real-world phenomena. Teachers will investigate the behavior and role of light through studies of the seasons, the production of food by plants, and the weather.

All class meetings will take place through distance learning. The instructor and participants will communicate via Moodle — the course platform on the Internet. Assignments and discussion forums will be facilitated in Moodle.
