This two hour recertification course entitled **SC² South Carolina - Self Control** developed by Dr. Sue Smith-Rex and produced in cooperation with the State Department of Education's Guidance Services, is designed for elementary teachers, school counselors and administrators. **In order to take this class, you need to be employed in a school/district to meet the requirements of working with the students, staff, and parents.** This course requires a learning team of elementary teachers, a school counselor and selected administrator. The school counselor is a key participant in the learning team. The seven programs were produced by ITV with ETV to provide SC schools with an effective way to meet the requirements of the Safe School Climate Act. The SC² model consists of three levels: Empathy (a group lesson for entire class), Mediation (training for student leaders) and Self Monitoring - Self Control (one-on-one folder system for selected students needing more intensive feedback). These levels are outlined in the seven video programs and online packet that guides educators on how to facilitate the model. The Model shows Dr. Sue Smith-Rex working with students in the role of the teacher and guidance counselor in all three levels while utilizing the packet of materials. Dr. Sue Smith-Rex, educator and author, developed the content and serves as instructor. The model was piloted at Geiger Elementary School and they provide feedback/results. Course Requirements

1. View video lessons. One set of DVD lessons will be provided to each participant. The DVDs must be returned upon completion of the course in order to receive recertification credit. (Videos are only for educational use by S.C. schools.)
2. Participants are required to:
 - a. Meet with teachers regarding which grade levels will use the program, divide the program responsibilities and provide the training.
 - b. Both accountability tools are to be used pre and post.
 - c. In-service all additional teachers who will be involved.
 - d. Parents of students involved should be informed through a PTA meeting or a newsletter about the Safe School Climate Act and the new approach of addressing school bullying.
 - e. Implement the three-tiered model stressing with faculty throughout the school year that this is an ongoing process that must be consistently used in order for the students to see it as important and worth their effort.
 - f. Consistently use signing as part of the schools' behavior management efforts.
 - g. Select new peer mediators each grading period.
 - h. Provide parents with a six/nine week evaluation summary.
 - i. Submit a written summary team report to ITV discussing the above and sharing insights and suggestions as to how to make the program more effective. The 3-5 page report should address the components above.
 - j. Complete Video Viewer's Log and Final Course Evaluation Forms.
